

Directions from Junction 10 M1 (Luton Airport)

From Junction 10 exit right (if coming from South) / left (if coming from North) at junction roundabout. Go straight over the next roundabout, (towards Luton Airport) and down the hill to a series of three small roundabouts. Bear left at first roundabout to next roundabout (25 metres), turn right (signposted Wheathampstead), then at next roundabout go straight over. (B653 Lower Luton Road)

Follow this road (approx. 4-5 miles) to next small roundabout (Alldays supermarket is on left just before the roundabout). Go straight over. Follow this road until you reach the next roundabout (2 miles)

Turn right at the roundabout (signposted Wheathampstead). Go through the village until you reach the church (on right). Turn right at the church (Church Street, leading into Brewhouse Hill).

Near the crest of the hill the office is set back from the road on the left hand side. The car park is directly across the road.

Directions from A1(M):

Exit A1 at J4 (if travelling North, it's the one immediately after the Hatfield Tunnel), coming off the A1 intersection roundabout, take the exit for Welwyn Garden City and look for signs for the B653 to Wheathampstead.

This will take you down a short dual carriageway going downhill to a roundabout. Turn left under the bridge to another small roundabout, where you take the 3rd exit – the B653 to Wheathampstead.

Follow this road for about 5 miles (passing Brocket Hall and a pub called the Crooked Chimney), until you come to a roundabout, where you take the first exit, Marford Road, leading into Wheathampstead.

At the end of Marford Road you will come to a mini-roundabout opposite a pub called the Swan. Turn right into the High Street, then immediately left by the Church. This is Church Street, which becomes Brewhouse Hill.

The Old Brewhouse is set back from the road on the left near the brow of the hill. The car park is across the road, immediately opposite.
